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Sub.: Training Programme at District level for Pilgrims of Haj 1443 (H) – 2022 (C.E.)

A Quota of 56,601 seats for Haj Committee of India has been allocated by the Ministry of Minority Affairs US (Haj Division), Government of India, via email dated 28th April, 2022 for Haj-2022.

2. As part of preparations for Haj pilgrimage, Training of intending Pilgrims is to be conducted at District Level in a phased manner under the supervision of respective State Haj Committee. The State Haj Committee must ensure 100% attendance of the pilgrims in these Training Camps on the stipulated date and time so that they are comprehensively trained by the Trainers. It is expected that each Haji is given at-least **2/3 Training Sessions by the Trainer** before proceeding for Haj broadly covering the Haj rituals, logistics and health cum hygiene. Complete details are available in this office Circular No.3 dated 7th December, 2021, which is available on the website of Haj Committee of India. The tentative Model Training Calendar for Training of Haj Pilgrims is as under :-

4	Report to HCoI by concerned SHC.	Subsequent to conduct of final Training session.
